**MINUTES FOR THE REGULARLY SCHEDULED VILLAGE COUNCIL
MEETING: WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 18, 2023 AT 6:00 P.M.
IN THE LIBRARY CONFERENCE ROOM**

1. Call to Order
