MINUTES FOR THE SPECIAL SCHEDULED VILLAGE COUNCIL MEETING: WEDNESDAY NOVEMBER 30, 2023 AT 6:00 P.M. IN THE JEMEZ SPRINGS BATH HOUSE

- 1. Trustee Sanchez called meeting to order at 1800.
 - a. Members Present: Monique Alton, Manolito (Mano) Sanchez, Robert (Bob) Wilson, Heather Gutierrez
 - b. Members Absent: Mayor Roger Sweet, Pro-Temp Dave Ryan
 - c. Others: Rose Fenton, Michael Nealeigh, Fred Simmank, Betsy Daub, Michael Dunphey, Eric Beacham, Raymond Sandoval, Lance Buchmiller, Liz Shulman, Michael Vangundy, Jerimiah Gorham, Chief Moreno, Officer Hernandez
- 2. Pledge of allegiance
- 3. Mano read the email Rose sent to the EPA, about new sewer line issue, once she was notified.
 - a. Manhole that is affected has extensive amount of roots blocking pipe.
 - b. Bob asks for water office to be notified when the sewer plant will be using the fire hydrants to clearing the blockage.
 - c. There's a possibility of more extensive amount of roots being found in other manholes.
 - d. Mano requests all manholes be inspected for more possible issues.
 - e. Rose mentions that when Daniel B Stephens was here inspecting manholes, the issues were taken care of as they were found.
 - i. DBS inspected most of the southern manholes.
 - f. Raymond asked why the sewer line was placed near the river.
 - i. Rose informed the public that the line was placed in over 50 years ago.
 - ii. Bob mentioned that at the time the lines were placed, there were multiple factors, one being the angle, and best location during that time.
 - iii. Rose mentioned that a camera was run through the sewer lines back in the day, & the video is on VHS Tapes.

- g. Liz asks why the line cannot be fixed as soon as possible.
 - Rose mentioned they have to get quotes to follow procurement procedures, as well as get approval from the council to spend money.
 - ii. Bob asks if this will be covered by ARPA Funds.
 - 1. Rose informed council ARPA <u>will only</u> cover to <u>replace</u>, <u>not</u> <u>repair</u> the issue.
- h. Monique mentions post related to sewer line issue.
 - i. Council recognizes that the locals should have been notified in a better & timelier manner.
 - ii. Mano informs the public that they were making the matter worse by blaming the Village.
- i. Eric Beachman asked if the meetings can be either videoed or recorded for the public that view.
 - i. Bob's reply was no, as the content can be cropped in order to put certain words or views that are skewed.
